These charities support the conservation of wildlife, landscapes, and ecosystems, both locally and nationally. Local & Regional Charities

(Worthing, West Sussex & South Coast)

Wildlife Conservation & Nature Protection

- **Sussex Wildlife Trust**
Protects local wildlife and habitats across Sussex, managing nature reserves and running conservation, education, and community engagement programmes.
 - **RSPB – Sussex & South Coast Reserves**
Manages coastal and inland reserves supporting bird conservation, habitat protection, and public education.
 - **Worthing Conservation Volunteers**
Local volunteer-led group supporting conservation and environmental projects in parks, woodlands, and public green spaces.

Coastal & Marine Conservation

- **Marine Conservation Society (South East Projects)**
Protects UK seas and coastlines through research, beach clean programmes, and education initiatives.
 - **Surfers Against Sewage (South Coast)**
Grassroots environmental charity campaigning to protect oceans, beaches, and waterways, with strong community involvement.

Local Green Spaces & Heritage Landscapes

- **National Trust – Sussex Properties & Coastline**
Protects historic landscapes, coastline, and green spaces across West Sussex and the South Downs.
 - **South Downs National Park Trust**
Supports conservation, access, and education within the South Downs National Park.

Wildlife & Habitat Protection

- **RSPB (Royal Society for the Protection of Birds)**
UK's largest nature conservation charity, protecting birds, habitats, and biodiversity nationwide.
 - **The Wildlife Trusts**
A network of local wildlife trusts working together to protect wildlife and wild places across the UK.
 - **Bat Conservation Trust**
Dedicated to the conservation of bats and their habitats in the UK.

Trees, Woodlands & Landscapes

- **Woodland Trust**
Protects ancient woodlands, plants trees, and promotes woodland conservation and education.
 - **Trees for Cities**
Supports tree planting and green spaces in urban areas to improve wellbeing and environmental resilience.

Marine & Coastal Conservation

- **Marine Conservation Society**
Protects seas, shores, and marine wildlife through research, advocacy, and community action.
 - **Blue Marine Foundation**
Works to restore marine ecosystems and protect ocean biodiversity.

Climate, Sustainability & Environmental Education

- **Friends of the Earth**
Campaigns for environmental protection, climate justice, and sustainability.
 - **Greenpeace UK**
Advocates for climate action, environmental protection, and biodiversity conservation.
 - **Keep Britain Tidy**
Promotes environmental responsibility, waste reduction, and community pride.

- **The Conservation Volunteers (TCV)**
Supports community-led conservation projects and volunteer opportunities across the UK.
 - **Groundwork UK**
Delivers environmental regeneration, green space creation, and sustainability projects in local communities.
 - **Field Studies Council**
Provides environmental education and outdoor learning opportunities for all ages.
