Supporting research, care, and comfort for those facing illness

Often chosen when a loved one was affected by a particular condition, received specialist care, or supported medical causes during their life. These charities range from local hospices and hospitals to national research and support organisations.



Local & Regional Health Charities

(Worthing, West Sussex & South Coast)

Care, Comfort & End-of-Life Support

- **St Barnabas House (Worthing & Arun)**

Local hospice providing specialist palliative and end-of-life care for adults with life-limiting illnesses, as well as support for families and carers. Widely supported through donations and in-memory giving.

- **Martlets Hospice (Brighton & Hove)**

Provides hospice care, symptom management, and bereavement support across the Sussex region.

- **Chestnut Tree House (Arundel)**

Children's hospice supporting babies, children and young people with life-limiting and life-threatening conditions, alongside their families.

Hospitals & Local NHS Support

- **Worthing Hospital Charity**

Supports enhanced patient care, equipment, and wellbeing projects at Worthing Hospital.

- **Friends of Worthing Hospital**

Long-standing local charity supporting hospital services, facilities, and patient comfort.

- **Western Sussex Hospitals NHS Charity**

Supports hospitals across Worthing, St Richard's (Chichester) and Southlands with funding for equipment, staff wellbeing, and patient experience.

Condition-Specific Local Support
